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# PTA'S Reflections Program

This is a program for ALL students.

PTA membership is required by someone in the participating student's household. The student themselves may even be the PTA member.

The PTA presents this year's Reflections program. The Reflections program was designed to give every student a chance to show case their creative side. Students are given a theme to reflect on and then create a work of art in any of the six

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categories within the program based on their interpretation of the theme. This year's theme is "Within Reach". This is called a program and not a contest because every student that enters will be recognized and rewarded for their work, but students who enter a work that earns them top honors can have their entries advanced to the next level for judging. At the top level (National PTA) of judging students can earn scholarship and grant money if their entry earns top honors.

#### The Break Down of Reflections

- 1. Program is open to all students. There is even a Special Artist Division for students who may need extra assistance from an adult to complete their projects.
- 2. This is not a mandatory program. It is strictly voluntary.
- 3. Students may not have any help from an adult in coming up with their project idea, but may have help in some areas when creating it. Please see individual category rules for more details.
- 4. Entry forms and category rules are available in the front office or online at <u>www.txpta.org/reflections</u>.
- 5. All entries are due by the end of October 2017.
- 6. Students reflect on this year's theme "Within Reach" and create a work of art in any or all of the 6 categories.
- All entries will go through a judging process to see if they can advance to the next level. There are 4 levels of judging: local (Briscoe), District (NISD), State, and National. At the National PTA level grant and scholarship money is awarded to top honors.

<u>The Categories are:</u> Photography, Visual arts, Film Production, Music Composition, Literature, and Dance Choreography.

The artwork accompanying the theme logo was provided by one of our own here at Briscoe.
