<u>1) Formal Uniforms</u> – The uniform distribution started yesterday! <u>Students will keep the uniforms until the end of the year</u>. This will be the uniform for the Holiday Concert and all other formal concerts/contests. The uniform consists of:

- Ladies: Concert Gown
- <u>Gentlemen: Tuxedo</u> (coat, pants, shirt & bow tie). Bow ties are \$5 to replace. Don't lose them! Please have them try on their uniform at home. Most if not all uniforms will need some sort of hemming. Please, <u>do not use scissors to hem up the uniform.</u> Hem tape is recommended. Also, students MUST wear black dress SOCKS & black dress SHOES.

<u>2) Band Pictures on Holiday Concert Day</u> – Tuesday, December 17th - A group picture will be taken at the beginning of each band class. Individual pictures will be taken shortly thereafter. As the group picture will be part of this year's yearbook, students who do not bring uniforms will not be included.

BAND UNIFORM PANTS ALTERATIONS

OBJECTIVE: To be able to alter the length (shorter/longer) of the trouser/pant of the band uniform WITHOUT cutting off any fabric.


OPTIONS:

- 1. Take trousers to a tailor/seamstress, STRESSING that no fabric be cut off.
- 2. Personally shorten or lengthen pants using "hemming tape." SEE STAPLED


EXAMPLES...available at Wal-Mart on Bandera/Mainland or at Hobby Lobby or Hancock Fabrics near Bandera/Huebner Rd.

HEMMING PROCEDURE:

- 1. Try to select a pair of slacks/trousers/pants that are longer than needed.
- 2. Have student try them on while wearing shoes that will be worn with uniform.
- 3. Use one or two straight pins that will mark the pant leg at the bottom that will determine the FINISHED LENGTH when worn.
- 4. Using straight pins, pin the hem tape over the outside edge of the pant leg(s), one at a time. SEE THE ILLUSTRATION BELOW.



- 5. Then turn the pants wrong side out.
- 6. FOLD UP each pant leg TO THE INSIDE, so that the STRAIGHT PIN marking the finished length (see step 3 above) is on the bottom edge. Then pin the hem up with straight pins. SEE ILLUSTRATION BELOW.



7. Either HAND STITCH (needle and thread) or MACHINE STITCH the edge to the pant leg. SEE ILLUSTRATION BELOW.
